- 1. Introduction
- 2. Minutes of the March 9, 2021 meeting. Hannah moved and Kristen seconded a motion to approve the minutes which were approve unanimously.
- 3. Treasurer's report: Hannah presented the report and noted that EID has \$36,151 in the bank and that we are expecting to get the last \$45,000 from DPW for 2020 soon. The report does not include an expenditure of \$5,000 for the LED light replacements. Missy moved and Jim seconded a motion to approve the financial report. It passed unanimously.
- 4. Memorandum of Agreement with the city: We seem to have finally come to an agreement with the city. The Foundation and the Civic League have approved the agreement and we should have a signature from the city by May.
- 5. Ash trees we have received an estimate for treating the ash trees of \$9,120 for our 57 trees. The Foundation will make the down payment and we will pay the rest. The treatment will happen sometime between mid-May and mid-June. Jim move and Hannah seconded a motion to approve this expenditure. Missy noted that the concern about an ash tree being taken down on Cross Drive has been resolved. It could not be salvaged.
- 6. Membership Charlie has been approved for the Board by the city.
- 7. Liaison to the Foundation for strategic planning the Board discussed the strategic planning related to upgrades and maintenance of our infrastructure.
- 8. Board policies the current policies require a third party consultation every five years. It is not required by the EID legislation. The Board discussed this issue and decided to consult with Will about using a committee from the neighborhood.
- 9. Future meetings it was agreed that we would meet on the second Tuesday of the month and meet monthly. We also agreed to review that Board policies at the next meeting.
